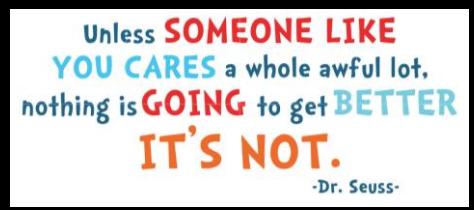


Angelica Kaiser

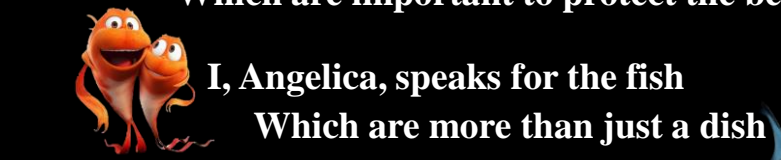


A team members

To stop ecosystem devastation



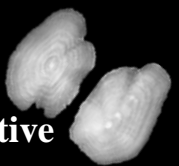
Radio tags to learn about their behaviour
